HUMANIZATION IN THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT

Visiting hours

Mornings: 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. **Afternoons:** 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

During visiting hours, a maximum of 2 visitors per patient room is allowed, with the possibility of exchanging visitors

One family member can stay with the patient 24 hours a day. An additional visitor is allowed from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Other family members may exchange places during visiting hours.

Two visitors are allowed for 24 hours, and they may exchange places with other family members

ICU VISITATION RULES

Visiting hours for family members in the unit are extended to:

Mornings: 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm Afternoons: 6:00 pm - 10:00 pm

- The patient will decide whether or not to receive visitors and when the visit
 will end, within the established visiting hours. A maximum of 2 companions
 will be allowed during visiting hours.
- The patient will decide whether or not they want their companions to be informed, and medical information will be provided during the visit.
- It is not allowed to interrupt the work of the health care personnel in charge of the patient, to interact with other families and/or patients, or to wander around the unit.
- It is forbidden to bring medication and food to the patient.
- Companions must maintain order and discipline in the unit, as it is the work area of health professionals.
- It is strictly forbidden to film or record audio within the unit, which
 constitutes a crime and grounds for a relevant complaint. The use of mobile
 phones or electronic devices for recreational purposes or for the patient to
 contact family is only allowed.
- Minors are not allowed to enter, except with express authorization.
- If necessary, healthcare personnel may request the evacuation of a specific box or the entire ICU.
