## PERINATAL LOSS: THE EMOTIONAL IMPACT OF THE DEATH OF ONE OF THE TWINS ON THE FAMILY AND PROFESSIONAL TEAM IN A NICU

## INTRODUCTION

Vanesa and Rafa began their paternity prematurely with the birth of their twins: Pau born at 25,1 gestational weeks (GW) while Héctor remained intrauterus for a further 11 days having being born with 26,6 GW. Both were aware of the risks due to the extreme prematurity, but nothing predicted the death of the second twin who died at 47 days of age. After facing grief due to the extreme prematurity of their children, these parents lived the hardest moment of their lives: whilst mourning the death of their son, they had to remain strong in order to continue supporting Pau in the same NICU where they said goodbye to Héctor.
