Dr Sánchez-Yague was awarded his Degree in Medicine and Surger the Malaga University in 1999 and completed his Doctorate in 2002. He Macarena Hospital in Seville, Spain. completed his residency in the Digestive System speciality at the Virgen Macarena Hospital between 2003 and 2007 and was International Scholar at the California Pacific Medical Center in San 2007 – Digestive System Specialist at the Costa del Sol Hospital, Marbella. Spain. Francisco in 2006, where he worked with Doctors Ken Binmoeller and Roy Soetikno. 2008 - California Pacific Medical Center in San Francisco, USA.

In 2007 he joined the Costa del Sol Hospital and left this position when he 2009 - Top Reviewer Award received from the Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Journal. obtained an international scholarship that would take him back to San 2011 – Pioneer in Spain in the introduction of the submucosal endoscopic Francisco. In 2010 he moved to Japan to complete his training in the dissection technique. submucosal endoscopic dissection technique that he would later on introduce in Andalusia in 2011, thus becoming one of the pioneers in the 2011 – First professional in the world to use the AXIOS (15mm) stent for performance of this technique in Spain. In 2011 he became the first pancreatic fluid collection drainage. medical professional in the world to use the 15-mm AXIOS stent in 2016 - Gold Medal of the Andalusian Society for Digestive Disease (SAPD, in its pancreatic fluid collection drainage. Spanish abbreviation).

In 2018 he began to perform gastroenteroanastomosis with luminal 2017 - Fellow of the American College of Gastroenterology (FACG). apposition stent in patients with pancreatic cancer and bowel obstruction, 2018 - Pioneer in Andalusia to perform gastroenteroanastomosis with luminal thus becoming a pioneer in Andalusia to perform such technique. apposition stent to treat bowel obstruction.

He is a coauthor of the reference guides of the European Society of 2019 - Fellow of the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (FASGE). Gastrointestinal Endoscopy on the endoscopic treatment of chronic pancreatitis and non-variceal gastrointestinal haemorrhage.






